An Act relating to the administration of the public revenues in the Town of Calculta.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Collector of Calcutua ${ }^{*}$ * * should have power to employ any Deputy Collector subordinate to him, in the performance of any part of the duties of his office; it is enacted as follows :-

1. (Regulations modified.)-Rep. by the Amending Act, 1891 (XII of 189 I).
2. [Collector to have charge of collection of stamp duty in Calcutta.]-Rep. by the General Stanip Act, 1869 (XVIII of 1869).
3. It shall be lawful for the Collector of Calcuta to employ any Deputy Collector subordinate to him in the preformance of any part
 Act XXIII of $1850^{4}$; and all Rules, Regulations and Acls relating to the office of Deputy Collector shall be of the same force within the lown of Calcutta as in other parts of the territories subject to the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal.
