(The Calcutta Land-revenue Act, 1856.)<sup>1</sup>

*An Act relating to the administration of the public revenues in the Town of Calcutta.*

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Collector of Calcutta<sup>2</sup> \* \* \* should have power to employ any Deputy Collector subordinate to him, in the performance of any part of the duties of his office; it is enacted as follows :—

Preamble.

1. (*Regulations modified.*)—*Rep. by the Amending Act, 1891 (XII of 1891).*

2. [*Collector to have charge of collection of stamp duty in Calcutta.*]*—Rep. by the General Stamp Act, 1869 (XVIII of 1869).*

3. It shall be lawful for the Collector of Calcutta to employ any Deputy Collector subordinate to him in the performance of any part of the duties of his office under <sup>3</sup>\* \* \* \* \* Act XXIII of 1850<sup>4</sup>; and all Rules, Regulations and Acts relating to the office of Deputy Collector shall be of the same force within the town of Calcutta as in other parts of the territories subject to the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal.

Collector may entrust any part of his duties to his Deputy.
